

**Addendum No. 2 to the
Memorandum of Understanding
between
Participating UN Organizations¹,
and
United Nations Development Programme (UNDP)
regarding the Operational Aspects of a
UN Joint-Project to Address Cooking Fuel Needs, Environmental Degradation and
Food Security for Populations Affected by the Refugee Crisis
in
Bangladesh**

WHEREAS, the Participating United Nations Organizations signing this Addendum No. 2 to the Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to collectively as the “Participating UN Organizations”) have developed a “**UN Joint-Project to Address Cooking Fuel Needs, Environmental Degradation and Food Security for Populations Affected by the Refugee Crisis**” (hereinafter referred to as the “Programme”) starting on **01 September 2018** and ending on **31 December 2021**² (hereinafter “End Date”), as may be amended from time to time, as part of their respective development cooperation with the Government of **Bangladesh** (hereinafter referred to as the “Host Government”), as more fully described in the Joint Programme Document dated 25 November 2018³, (hereinafter referred to as the “Joint Programme Document”), a copy of which is attached hereto as ANNEX A, and have agreed to establish a coordination mechanism (hereinafter referred to as the “Steering Committee”) ⁴ to facilitate the effective and efficient collaboration between the Participating UN Organizations and the Host Government for the implementation of the Programme;

WHEREAS, in Addendum No. 1 signed on 13 September 2021 the Steering Committee approved the revised Joint Programme document and extended the Joint Programme until 31 December 2021.

NOW, THEREFORE, on 13 December 2021, the Steering Committee has decided to extend the Joint Programme until 30 June 2022.

The Memorandum of Understanding between the Participating UN Organizations and the UNDP’s MPTF Office (acting as Administrative Agent) is therefore modified as follows:

All other terms and conditions of the Memorandum of Understanding remain unchanged.
