Support for Green Recovery)	Impact of COVID 19 on green enterprises UNIDO, in cooperation with ILO, launched a global study in September 2021 called, "Impact of COVID 19 on green enterprises: Policy guidance towards inclusive, resilient, and sustainable recovery," focusing on India, Ghana, and Uruguay. The study investigates the impact of COVID 19 on green SMEs, to what extent it hinders SMEs from implementing SDGs, and what would be a sustainable mechanism for SMEs to recover and transform. The study also identifies the new business opportunities and jobs that stem from the pandemic. The findings of the analysis will craft recommended policy guidance for enterprises, financial institutions, international organizations, and national government.
	A review of the literature was done to understand the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on MSMEs and jobs across the world. A comprehensive questionnaire was prepared for the Green MSMEs based on a detailed literature review. In January, a survey questionnaire was sent to 900 SMEs in three countries to capture their challenges, impact on their operations and employees, mechanisms adopted to deal with the pandemic, and support received from the government. Stakeholders from the business chambers and associations, Government bodies, non-government

organizations, civil society organizations, banking institutions, and funding agencies
have been identified to conduct focused group discussions in February 2022.

The set-up of the workshop would be an opening by PAGE representatives, technical exchanges between the participants and PAGE representatives, and three deep-dive sessions on Asia, Africa, Latin America and the Caribbean. 	In 2021, UNIDO completed the study "Unlocking Demand for Biomaterials in South Africa" as a follow-up to the action plan and implementation strategy for Biomaterials in South Africa in 2018. The study was commissioned with the request of the Department of Forestry, Fisheries and the Environment, and the Department of Science and Innovation, South Africa, to identify the existing and potential markets and associated marketing strategies, which are critical in driving biomaterials' growth in South Africa. The study also examines five policy options to stimulate demand for bioplastics, including bans and quotas on traditional plastics, taxes or levies on traditional plastics, the use of standards and labels to indicate sustainability, green procurement, and social awareness. A virtual validation workshop was held on 2 February 2021 to disseminate the findings and receive feedback from stakeholders. 133 participants from various ministries, including the Department of Economic Development and Tourism Mpumalanga, Department of trade and industry Department of Public Enterprises, think tanks like Council for Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR- South Africa), companies, and representatives from the UN agencies and diplomatic mission joined the workshop.

	In collaboration with the Civil House State Secretary in Mato Grosso, UNIDO under PAGE conducted a comprehensive assessment for the sustainable management of the Historic Centre of Cuiaba. The aim of this study was to explore the ways of sustainable management of Historic Centre with particular focus on the preservation and to introduce a Land Use and Urban mobility Plan focused on the conservation of the Centre. The Plan includes recommendations and policy measures for resource efficiency and raise awareness on sustainability, natural resources, cultural heritage preservation, and local economic development. The plan was finalized in October 2021.
	Industrial Policy Strategy for the Forestry-based Industry UNIDO and the Federation of Industries in Mato Grosso are jointly developing an Industrial Policy Strategy for the forestry-based industry to review and improve the efficiency of relevant value chains, e.g., firewood, sawn timber, charcoal, cellulose and paper, and propose policy recommendations. In March 2021, a workshop followed with relevant stakeholders of the private sector, the Secretariat for the Environment of the State of Mato Grosso and the wood association to discuss policies and priorities for the forest sector. Building on this, UNIDO is conducting further evidence-based research to determine the costs and benefits of new industry standards, and identify priorities and development strategies to encourage innovation and business sustainability in the industry.
	Greening the supply chain of export-oriented livestock farming products UNIDO, together with the Mato Grosso Meat Institute (IMAC), is supporting the development of national policy guidelines to promote the greening of export- oriented livestock farming product supply chains. In May 2021, UNIDO commenced the analysis and identification of production systems and technologies that can be used for livestock production, as well as practices and policy recommendations for the restoration of degraded rangelands and reforestation in production chains. With the support of the Mato Grosso Meat Institute, a survey of producers in the state on sustainable livestock production has also been carried out, along with other assessments of the current situation.

	These will be incorporated into the development of guidance documents, which will be disseminated through training.

The Observatory will serve as an important monitoring tool to produce more transparent and publicly available information on qualified labour, future skills profiles in workforce projections, and consultation and dialogue mechanisms with all relevant stakeholders in the sector. 	In the Kyrgyz Republic, UNIDO is working with the Ministry of Energy and Industry to develop a National Industrial Resource Efficiency Policy to promote climate-friendly industrial development. The activity was kicked off on 24 August 2021 with the meetings with the counterpart Ministry of Industry. On 16 December 2021, a stakeholder consultation meeting was organized with representatives from the Ministry of Economy, Ministry of Industry, representatives from cement and metal industries, and other stakeholders to populate the policy development work, collect input and disseminate survey questionnaire to the stakeholders. A detailed survey was conducted with 15 selected resource intensive industries and, a team of international and national experts visited five industrial plants to conduct an in-depth assessment of the status of industries toward resource efficiency and cleaner production practices, and opportunities for resource savings. In addition, the team plans to conduct interviews with the relevant policy expert to design the policy layout. Based on the collected data and analysis, UNIDO will draft a national industrial resource efficiency policy for the adoption of the government.

The immediate focus was the establishment of a "Sustainable Production Board" in 2020 and the following Studies that were jointly completed by UNIDO and the Ministry of Productive Development in 2021: 1) Circular Economy National Plan Study;
	 2) Fiscal Impact Study of the implementation of the Circular Economy National Plan; 3) Technical feasibility study for a National Circular Economy Registry (Digital System). The studies are an integral part of the National Green Productive Development Plan to align the country's production with the global climate agenda. The objective of the Plan is to incorporate environmental sustainability concerns (e.g., recycling and recovery rates achieved for different waste streams) in policies of the productive sectors.

Support for Green Recovery)	UNIDO began to support the development of a roadmap for the generation of power from the sugarcane industry in the North-West region of Argentina. The aim is to understand relevant aspects of the sugar and energy chain within the context of circular economy, the role of bioethanol in the decarbonization process of Argentina's energy matrix and the economic benefits of greening the sector and reuse of waste throughout the chain. 	UNIDO in cooperation with ILO, initiated a study, deepening the green economy stocktaking, with analysis focused on select manufacturing sub-sectors in India. The study aims to appraise key macro drivers for growth of the economy and employment creation in India and map high impact opportunities to initiate the transition towards inclusive, green growth. The first draft report of the study 'Shaping India's Inclusive and Green Economy: Mobilizing Green Transformation in Select MSME Manufacturing Sectors' was prepared by the Confederation of Indian Industry (CII), and stakeholder consultations were held with representatives from industry associations, think tanks, research organizations, civil society, PAGE agencies and government partners. Based on the CII study and consultations held in 2020, the textile and garment sectors were identified, for further analysis. A meeting was held between ILO and UNIDO on 5 May 2021, to discuss further strengthening of the report submitted by CII and to plan next steps.

	As part of a joint effort of UNIDO, UNDP, and UNEP under PAGE to develop the National Project "Zhasyl Kazakhstan" (Green Kazakhstan) spearheaded by the Ministry of Ecology, Geology and Natural Resources of Kazakhstan, UNIDO developed an action plan for the Industrial waste section of the Green Kazakhstan programme. The action plan outlines key objectives, a vision, tasks, results indicators, challenges, required resources, and responsible authorities for implementing the programme. For developing the programme, eight working group meetings were held with the Ministry to discuss the content and design of the National project. In September 2021, two seminars were organized on Industrial waste in Kostanay and Karaganda industrial region to share the best approaches in industrial waste management and identify indicators for industrial waste management to be included in the national programme. A total of 48 participants from industries, regional governments, NGOs, and academia joined the two seminars. On 9 October 2021, the government officially approved the national project Zhasyl Kazakhstan (Green Kazakhstan) for implementation.
	Promotion of green SMEs
	In cooperation with the Ministry of Ecology, Geology, and Natural Resources of the Republic of Kazakhstan (MEGNR) and the Pavlodar Regional Government, UNIDO initiated a pilot initiative in February 2021 on energy efficiency in buildings. This initiative focuses on using an emissions payment fund for subsidizing green SMEs in the form of Interest rate subsidies on bank loans and producing guidelines on the efficient use of the emission payments fund.

	On behalf of UNIDO, the Thailand Development Research Institute (TDRI), as the key national partner, is conducting a Green Economy Stocktaking Study to identify major gaps for a green economic transformation and entry points for the PAGE programme in Thailand. The study explores different thematic areas, including green jobs, the Bio-Circular-Green economic model (BCG model), energy, finance, digitalization, and capacity development for a green economy. Two virtual workshops were organized in September 2021 and in January 2022, inviting representatives from PAGE, government, UN, and research institutes to share the findings and receive feedback. A draft report was circulated in December 2021 to the stakeholders for written feedback. The stocktaking identifies several priority interventions for PAGE in Thailand: policy restructuring for decarbonization, technology, and innovation for Bio-Circular and Green economy, waste management, sustainable finance, capacity building, and revision of regulations. With the PAGE Economic Policy Advisory Group (PEPAG) support, a chapter on sustainable finance has been added to the green economy stocktaking to inform and guide PAGE interventions in this area.
