I. Purpose

The present project intends to assist Iraq in its endeavors for the reconstruction of its economic infrastructure. It will particularly provide support for the rehabilitation of the Specialized Institute for Engineering Industries (SIEI), which due to the war and subsequent sanctions has suffered extensive damage, including the total or partial destruction of its laboratories and production workshops. The successive conflicts have also hindered its technical capacities and access to new information on modern technologies, international standards and quality assurance systems.

Under this project, assistance will be provided to rebuild the capacity of the SIEI to assist the Iraqi industries with the application of national standards and adaptation of international standards to their needs, to carry out proper quality assurance activities and testing of industrial products and to seek international recognition of its competence through accreditation. The project will particularly provide assistance in:

- Training a substantial number of SIEI managerial and technical staff on standardization, quality assurance, and conformity assessment (testing, inspection and certification) subjects;
- Acquiring appropriate instrumentation, equipment and reference materials for its testing/calibration laboratories and production workshop; and
- Initiating testing and other product quality assurance activities for the local manufacturing industry, service sector and consumers.

The project will include significant emphasis on technology transfer related to operational techniques, procedures and policies issues.

Project outcomes:

- Enhanced capacity of the SIEI/Ministry of Industry to respond to the needs of the manufacturing industry, service sector and consumers and facilitate industrial development in Iraq.
- Industry has access to improved services that would enable precision manufacture and quality improvement of their products.

II. Resources

Financial Resources:

- The project is solely financed through the Fund: \$4,237,722. The Government is providing an in-kind contribution estimated to \$600,000.

III. Implementation and Monitoring Arrangements

UNIDO has overall responsibility for implementation of the project and the appropriate use of the funds allocated. Four entities are involved in the project's implementation: (1) UNIDO headquarters, (2) the UNIDO Iraq Office in Jordan, (3) Ministry of Industry and (4) the Specialized Institute for Engineering Industries. A system of close collaboration has been built between the entities with frequent exchange of information about the project's aims and objectives, i.e. outcomes of project assessments, the recommended equipment to be purchased, building renovation works to be done and capacity building to be organized.

Monitoring of the activities is done through regular Programme Steering Committee meetings, regular reporting by the national field staff and frequent interaction with the two lead ministries, Ministry of Industry and Minerals and the Specialized Institute for Engineering Industries. In addition meetings are held regularly with the national field staff.
